He turned around to see his girlfriend Saori. “Why did you take so long?” Dave asked. “I had to go to work for a little bit to pick up some things. Sorry. Were you waiting long?” He shook his head. “Why do we have to get here this early anyway? I thought we have \*reserved seats.” “We do,” answered Dave, “but I want to see everything. I really think Kuroda is going to win today.”

The line they were in moved slowly towards the gate.
