Alain was a strong and handsome man, he was quick to learn and his skill with the \*sword was so good that his teachers liked him. He talked ( ② ) many people in the castle and was very popular at the parties. Many people had high hopes for Alain’s future.

On the other hand, Cecil was not interested ( ③ ) learning or playing sports, and didn’t like to talk to people. He was not good with a sword, and he did not go to the parties at the castle.

Cecil always enjoyed ④( play ) in the forest near the castle and looking for herbs. The forest was a place of great natural beauty, with many flowers and plants.

Cecil was lying in the grass, looking at the blue sky and thinking. “The sky is blue and beautiful today. I’m so happy.”

The small country had to be careful ( ⑤ ) attacks from other countries. Therefore, it was also \*necessary to make their army bigger and to give them more training.

Two years passed and it was time for the two princes to work for the country’s army and the castle.

The king and the people of the castle had high hopes for Alain. In fact, Alain won battles with other countries and \*protected his country.

Alain made the small country’s army stronger and its businesses more successful. The small country was richer than two years ago. Alain became a popular hero.

On the other hand, Cecil was still in the forest. He said, “The sky is blue and beautiful today. I’m so happy.” He ⑥( stop ) his work in the army and in the castle,

and enjoyed himself every day in the forest.

“Alain is a good prince. But Cecil is not. We don’t know what he is thinking, and he just plays in the forest every day without doing any work.” The people in the castle talked like this, and some of them were trying to make Cecil go away from the castle.

It’s true that Cecil didn’t do any work in the castle, and he was quiet. But he was not lazy, he was a clever man.

He just didn’t like to fight with other people. He was very positive about things that interested him, and he even recorded all the flowers and plants in the forest into a book.

He wrote fourteen plant \*encyclopedias and studied plants and flowers as a hobby in the \*underground rooms of the castle.
