### 1 Oliver's trip to Japan

There are many European students who are interested ( ① ) Japan. An Italian university student named Oliver is one ( ② ) them. He lives in Milan and became interested ( ① ) Japan when he saw a Japanese movie. He can speak Japanese a little because he studied Japanese in high school. Also, by using SNS he has found Japanese friends and enjoys chatting on the Internet with them. Perhaps the best way to learn a language is to talk to people in that language, not just study it. It is also important to travel to the country and experience the culture directly. For this reason, Oliver decided to travel to Japan ( ③ ) the summer holidays. It is a student trip of about one month.

### 2 Walking around the city

Oliver traveled to Tokyo, Osaka and then to Hiroshima and he stayed in an old hotel. "While traveling in Japan, Tokyo and Osaka are the most famous cities. But if you want to know more about Japanese culture than just sightseeing, you have ( ④ ) go to smaller cities," he thought to himself. After arriving at the hotel, he took a bus tour of Hiroshima and went for daily walks around the city.

⑤One day, when he walked along a big stone street, he saw a beautiful yellow shop on the corner of the street. The shop was light yellow with a sunflower sign. ### 3 Memories of yellow lemons

Oliver has liked lemons since he was a child because his mother usually made lemon dishes. He has two brothers and a sister. All four of them like fruit, so they often had fruit dishes ⑦(cook) by their mother. ⑧One of ( ) ( ) ( ) foods was the lemon one. Lemons are the king of vitamins and are good for your health, so there were three ways to use lemons in his family.

First, there were the lemon-based dinner foods, for example lemon salad and chicken or pork cooked with lemon. He still remembers the fresh taste and the wonderful \*smell. These beautiful looking dishes were placed on the dinner table and his father enjoyed these meals with a glass of white wine. It was a nice family time.

Secondly, there were sweets made with lemons in the afternoon. The table in his house was sometimes set with lemon sweets. His mother always bought fresh lemons at the market. After cooking with them, she used the other lemons to make sweets, for example lemon cookies and lemon cakes. He and his sister loved those sweets. They liked to put them in a basket and have a picnic in the garden or take a walk in the park. Sometimes they also gave them to their friends. They were very happy to receive these homemade sweets.

The last thing their mother always made was a lemon drink on weekends. He played card games and quiz games with his brothers in his room on weekends. At these times, his mother sometimes made and brought cold lemon drinks for the children, for example lemon soda, pink lemon juice and lemonade. Lemon is a fruit that also goes well with oranges and limes. Adding sugar or honey to lemon drinks also helps to \*restore tired bodies. These refreshing drinks are great to drink on a hot summer's day. ⑨Oliver continued his walk ( ) he thought about these things. His interest in Japanese culture continues.
